

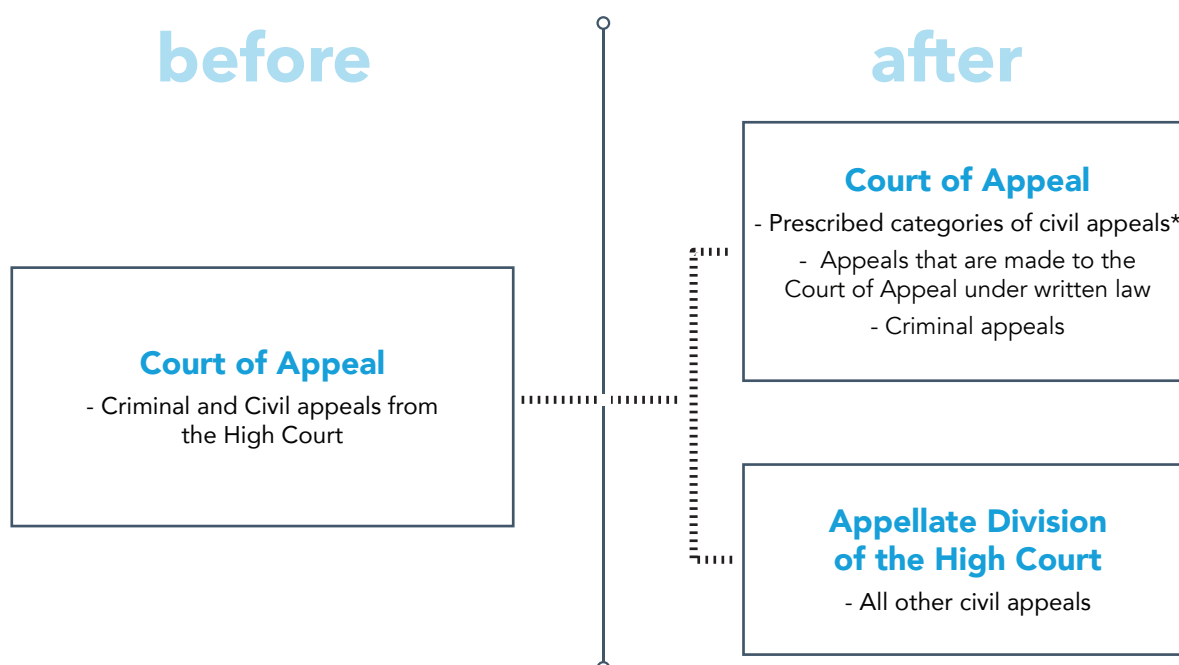
New Distribution of Appeals

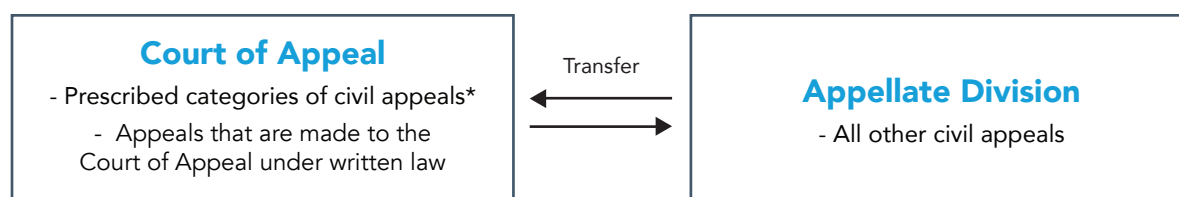
Ordinary Allocation of Appeals

Flexibility to Transfer Civil Appeals

The Court of Appeal will have the powers to transfer civil appeals between the two appellate courts. This ensures that the Court of Appeal can decide points of law of public importance that may arise in any case.
