

## Renegotiating Business Contracts with the Re-Align Framework

## The Process

Between **15 January and 26 February 2021**, the Re-Align Framework will enable eligible small and micro businesses who have been significantly impacted by COVID-19 to renegotiate selected types of business contracts with their contract partners. A summary of the Re-Align Framework process is illustrated below.

From 15 January to 26 February 2021 1 An Affected Business that wishes to seek assistance under the Re-Align Framework has to serve a **Notice of Negotiation** on the other party or parties to the contract ("Other Party") latest by 26 February 2021

4 weeks
Negotiation
Period

2 Parties have a 4-week Negotiation Period. They should discuss, understand each other's positions and try to find a mutually acceptable way of realigning the contract to the new business environment

2 weeks
Objection Period

**3** Parties proceed with amended contract, or terminate contract on mutually agreed terms

If successful

If the Other Party does not object to Affected Business's eligibility under the framework

If unsuccessful

**4a** Contract deemed terminated 2 days after Objection Period ends

If parties cannot agree on obligations upon termination

5 Parties may lodge **Notice for Adjustment.** Case goes to Assessor If (i) the Other Party objects to the Affected Business's eligibility under the framework, or if (ii) the Other Party is a small landlord seeking compensation

4b The Other Party lodges (i) Notice of Objection and/or (ii) Notice for Compensation.
Contract continues while case goes to Assessor

**2 weeks** after Objection

Notice for Adjustment

Period to lodge



Assessor's determination can also cover the liabilities and obligations, with appropriate adjustments, upon termination
