Mr Keith Magnus is Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of Evercore's Asia office, a major international financial institution headquartered in Wall Street. He has received over 30 awards from leading industry publications, including Best M&A Adviser in Asia, Best M&A Adviser in Singapore, as well as best deal awards for innovative thinking and the navigation of particularly complex large scale transactions.

Mr Magnus is the Founding Chairman of The Kallang Group, which owns and manages The Kallang precinct, Asia's premier destination for sports, entertainment and lifestyle anchored by the National Stadium, the Singapore Indoor Stadium, The Kallang Alive Masterplan, a key driver of Singapore's experience economy. He earlier served as Singapore's Chief Negotiator in the recovery of the then Singapore Sports Hub from the Government's Public-Private-Partnership (PPP) partner. He is also Chairman of the Families for Life Council under the Ministry of Social and Family Development, Deputy Chairman of Sport Singapore and Chairman of its Finance Committee, and a board member of the Anglo-Chinese Schools Foundation. He previously served as Director of Sentosa Development Corporation and chaired its Finance and Investments committee.

Mr Magnus holds double degrees in Accountancy (Economics) and Laws (BEc, LLB) from Monash University, Melbourne.
